Beagle Bill

An Act prohibiting animal experimentation and requiring the adoption of animal subjects.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section (1). An animal testing facility is prohibited from using the Commonwealth funds to directly support research on animal subjects.

Section (2). An animal testing facility shall require all animal subjects suitable for adoption to be offered for adoption.

Section (3). Definitions.

“Animal subject.” A dog or cat.

“Animal testing facility.” A facility, including a private entity, State agency or institution of higher education, that houses and uses animal subjects for research, testing or other scientific or medical purposes. The term shall not include diagnostic, treatment, or veterinary care of animal subjects.

“Institution of higher education.” A state-owned university, community college, or state-related institution.

Section (4). This shall take effect in 60 days.
