Prohibiting the Usage of AI in Schools

An Act prohibiting the usage of Artificial Intelligence within Public Schools in the Commonwealth.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section (1). Generative artificial intelligence may not be used in a school entity in this Commonwealth for the completion of the following:

- (1) Presentations;
- (2) Papers;
- (3) Art;
- (4) Assignments;
- (5) Any other work product of a student enrolled in a school entity of this Commonwealth.

Section (2). Definitions.

"Generative artificial intelligence." The class of models that emulate the structure and characteristics of input data in order to generate derived synthetic content, including information such as images, videos, audio clips or text, that has been significantly modified or generated by algorithms, including by artificial intelligence.

"School entity" shall mean a school district, private school, intermediate unit, area career and technical school, charter school, cyber charter school or regional charter school.

Section (3). This shall take effect in 60 days.
